UDC (Times New Roman, 12 pt, left-aligned)

Author's Full Name, academic degree, academic title (language of the abstract) - (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold, left-aligned)

Affiliation, Country - (Times New Roman, 12 pt, left-aligned). Line spacing after this section – 10 pt.

REPORT TITLE - (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold, centered, UPPERCASE)

Abstract. (Times New Roman, 12 pt, italics, justified). Up to 900 characters (including spaces).

Keywords: (Times New Roman, 12 pt, italics, justified). 5–10 words or phrases. Line spacing after this section – 10 pt.

Author's Name and Surname in English, academic degree, academic title (Ukrainian) - (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold, left-aligned)

Affiliation, Country (Ukrainian) - (Times New Roman, 12 pt, left-aligned). Line spacing – 10 pt.

REPORT TITLE (IN Ukrainian) - (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold, centered, UPPERCASE)

Abstract (Ukrainian) - Times New Roman, 12 pt, italics, justified. Up to 900 characters (including spaces).

Keywords: Times New Roman, 12 pt, italics, justified. 5–10 words or phrases. Line spacing – 10 pt.

Main Text. First-line indent: 1 cm. Times New Roman, 12 pt, regular, justified alignment. Line spacing – 10 pt.

References - (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold, centered)

The list should be formatted according to the National Standard of Ukraine **DSTU 8302:2015** or APA 7th edition.

For publication, only edited conference abstracts of 1–3 full pages with 2 cm margins on all sides will be accepted. Line spacing: single.

Figures and illustrations should be provided in .jpeg or .png formats.

The name of the file must correspond to the first author's surname in the language of the abstracts.



Publication Policy and Ethical Requirements:

- absence of plagiarism;
- absence of guest authorship (listing individuals who did not substantially contribute to the work);
- absence of ghost authorship (failure to acknowledge individuals who made a significant contribution).

Based on the results of the conference, a collection of theses will be created, which will be placed in the Institutional Repository of Ternopil Ivan Puluj National Technical University
